Four (4) years of experience in in building trades, inspection, or equivalent training, preferred. Must be able to maintain Erosion Control Inspector Certification through an accredited agency approved by the Director of Building and Code Enforcement within one (1) year of hire. International Code Council Residential Building, Electrical, Mechanical and/or Plumbing Inspector, preferred. Must possess a valid driver's license and acceptable driving record per the City's drivers *Use of Vehicles for City Business* policy throughout employment with the City.
